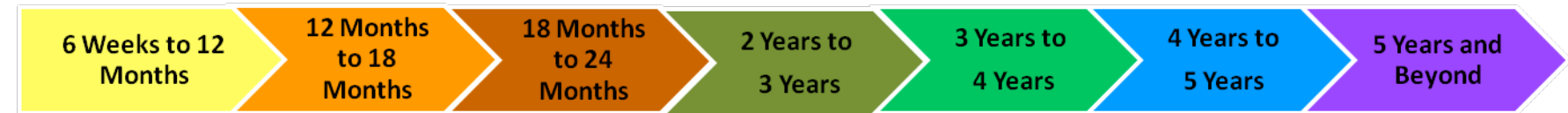


Child Development Timeline



6 weeks to 12 months

- smiling and cooing
- reaching and grasping objects
- rolling over
- sitting with and without assistance
- scooting to crawling

12 months to 18 months

- standing and taking first steps
- walking with and without assistance
- use of spoon and cup
- develops sense of self
- follows simple instructions

18 months to 24 months

- forms two word statements
- scribbles
- matches familiar objects
- imitates adult behaviors
- helps clean-up

2 years to 3 years

- asks for desired items
- runs in forward direction
- can throw/kick a ball
- begins to recognize names of colors/shapes
- asks questions

3 years to 4 years

- uses zippers/snaps/buttons
- attempts to use full sentences
- jumps with two feet together
- can count to 10
- wash hands without assistance

4 years to 5 years

- uses toilet independently
- uses scissors to cut on a line
- can group objects together
- tell stories with past and future tenses
- uses conjunctions to string words within a sentence

5 years and beyond

- concept of clock time relating to daily schedule
- shows interest in creative expression
- understanding of moral standards (fairness, right from wrong, honesty)
- begins to handle stressful situations without being overly upset
- starts to understand changes and ask questions about puberty
